# **Fire Evacuation Policy**

# **Policy Statement**

This policy sets out expectations regarding Activate Learning Education Trust (ALET) schools' responsibilities for their premises and emergency procedures in relation to fire.

### This Fire Evacuation policy is linked to:

- Risk Assessment Policy
- Incident and Accident Reporting Policy
- Examination Contingency Plan

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#### 1. Aims

This policy aims to ensure that ALET schools have a reduced risk of the outbreak of fire and that schools correctly determine the precautions needed to protect occupants and enable a safe means of escape if a fire occurred. Furthermore, ALET Schools follow and practise procedures for safe evacuation and will:

- Consider the presence of any dangerous substances and the risk this presents to relevant persons from fire
- Ensure that the premises and any equipment provided in connection with firefighting, fire detection and warning, or emergency routes and exits are covered by a suitable system of maintenance, and are maintained by a competent person in an efficient state, in efficient working order and in good repair
- Establish a suitable means of contacting the emergency services and provide them with any relevant information about dangerous substances

# 3. Responsibilities

### **The Trust Board**

The Trust board and their policy committee are responsible for monitoring this Fire Evacuation policy's effectiveness and holding the trust leadership group to account for its implementation.

# **ALET's Leadership Group**

The leadership group are responsible for ensuring this policy is adhered to and applied consistently.

# The ALET Health and Safety Officer

Will train and quality assure the work of a locally appointed 'responsible person' for fire safety.

# 4. Procedures and Related Documents

Each school will operate according to local procedures and related documents including:

- Ensuring that procedures are in place to reduce the likelihood of fire
- Maintain fire detection and alarm systems
- Ensure staff and pupils are familiar with emergency evacuation procedures
  Under the guidance of the ALET Health and Safety Officer, the leadership group will appoint a local responsible person in each school to conduct risk assessment and liaise with relevant colleagues accordingly.

The responsible person is required to:

- Carry out a fire risk assessment of the premises and review it regularly
- Tell staff or their representatives about the risks identified
- Put in place, and maintain, appropriate fire safety measures
- Plan for an emergency
- Provide staff information, fire safety instruction and training
